Eliana Lucia Ferreira has a doctorate and a master degree in Physical Education from the State University of Campinas, and also a post doctoral degree from the Federal University of Grande Dourados and a post-doctorate from the National University of Distance Education - UNED - Spain.

She developed her academic career at the Faculty of Physical Education at the Federal University of Juiz de Fora - UFJF and is a Lead Researcher at the Inclusion and Human Movement Research Center at UFJF.

She was General Coordinator of Special Education Policy at the Secretariat for Continuing Education, Literacy, Diversity, and Inclusion (SECADI/MEC) of the Brazilian Ministry of Education.

She was a UNESCO consultant for the Ministry of Education.

She was the founder and president of the Brazilian Wheelchair Dance Confederation (CBDCR) from 2001 to 2015 and 2024 to the present.

She is the Lead Professor of the Research Center for Inclusion, Movement, and Distance Learning - NGIME/UFJF.

For almost 20 years, Dr. Eliana research and publications related to educational inclusion and dance for people with disabilities.

She also teaches sports for disable people and accessibility education. With the support of the Ministry of Education, through online postgraduate courses, she has been the educational coordinator of more than 09 courses, responsible for training more than 10,000 teachers in Brazilian schools.

Author and editor of more than 50 books and 35 book chapters. Publication of 49 articles in periodicals, presentation of 109 papers at national and international congresses.

She has supervised 27 master students and 7 doctoral students.
